Introduction

Under the Mauritius-Africa Scholarship Scheme, the Government of the Republic of Mauritius offers scholarships to deserving students who are resident citizens of member states of the African Union for full-time, on-campus undergraduate (diploma/degree) and postgraduate programmes tenable in public Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in Mauritius.

Since its launch in 2013, some 80 African students have benefitted from the Mauritius-Africa Scholarship Scheme.

Conditions Attached to the Scholarships

- Candidates must be resident citizens of Member States of the African Union.
- Applicants should:
 - be above 18 years of age and should not have reached their 26th birthday by the closing date of application for undergraduate programmes;
 - 2. not have reached 35 years for Master's and 45 years for PhD programmes respectively by the closing date of application;
 - meet academic requirements set for the scholarships;
 and
 - 4. meet specific entry requirements of the programme applied for.

Financial Benefits of the Scholarship

- This scholarship provides for the payment of tuition fees and related course costs (such as general/annual fees and miscellaneous fees, etc) to be allocated yearly, directly to the TEIs.
- A monthly stipend of MUR 12,500 (USD 365) will be paid to awardees as support to meet living expenses in Mauritius.
- An Economy airfare by the most economical route, from the country of origin at the beginning of studies and back to the country of origin at the end of the studies.


